Lots of you have been asking about our planned production of "Matilda Jr". There are lots of singing and dancing numbers giving loads of scope for our middle and senior school students. In particular, if you've seen the West End Show you will know that there are lots of opportunities for the senior school to play adults or the "revolting" older students.

Matilda Jr will be performed at Redruth School from the 26th to 29th July 2023. Tickets will go on sale once pantomime is finished (January 2023).

The BLAST! (Bev-Lyn Adventures in Stage & Theatre) musical theatre sessions will start on Thursday 19th January. In addition to our dancing, these sessions are a chance to develop singing, acting and confidence too. We will have some fun with the show in the first few weeks, learning songs and dances, exploring characters and building team work. We will then cast principals after February half term.

The weekly Thursday classes will then be rehearsals for the show. Bev-Lyn students will get priority but sessions will ultimately be open to anyone aged between 8 and 18 at time of the show, if we have space. The cost will be £2 per week for Bev-Lyn students who do other classes and £6.15 for new musical theatre BLASTers.
